



Magnetic catches can be used anywhere a roller/ball catch would traditionally fit.

Magnetic catches are well suited for double door applications

because:

- **The catches never wear out**
- **No latch noise**
- **Completely concealed**
- **Easy installation!**

Magnetic Catch	Ball Catch
Clean look: No strike plate on the edge of the jamb	Visible strike plate on jamb
Smaller in diameter and less noticeable	Larger and noticeable from the front of the door
Magnetic closing, which is more durable	Spring loaded, can wear out over time and need to be replaced
Easy installation, no need to chisel out the space—just drill a hole to sink the cup in and add shims to increase the strength between the magnets	Need to machine for or chisel out the space and adjust the hardware on the door to close properly
Smooth closing, hardware is not meeting so nothing touches	Clunky closing due to the ball sliding into the catch
Very quiet, no click because the hardware does not meet	Audible click where the ball slides into the catch
Can be painted over or left as is, stainless steel finishes only	Cannot be painted over but there are a variety of finishes available to match the finishes of the hinges or door hardware
